“Being the only senior and upperclassman, I try to make sure to be a good role model,” said Tarrance, who has been getting varsity minutes since the eighth-grade. “Even when I’m not necessarily having the best game or practice, I try to keep a positive attitude and energy the girls can feed off of.

“I’m constantly checking on the girls and trying to resolve conflicts as quick as possible,” she added. “I’m kind of like the team mom in a way.”

Of the 16 players who have appeared in games this season for Grayson County, 10 are either freshmen or in middle school.

Her role as a leader is something McClintic has noticed, and appreciates.

“She’s a very caring teammate that makes sure everyone is fine and checks to see if they need anything,” McClintic said.

Tarrance, who has significantly increased her averages from 2.4 points and 3 rebounds a game last season, said moving into a role as a team leader is one that has had to grow on her throughout her career.

“As a senior, I’ve had to step into a role of a leader, which I wasn’t super comfortable in,” she said. “I think this far in the season though, I’ve adapted to it and try to be that for the girls. I also wasn’t always the best offensively and struggled with my confidence during the games ... I feel as though I’ve really gotten out of that mindset this year. I’ve gotten a lot better in my role as a forward and post player this year.

“I feel like the role on my team is positive energy and build up my teammates on and off the court,” she added.

Tarrance said her hustle and fight on the court is a trait she hopes is something her teammates can feed off of.

She also ranks among the Cougars’ top shooters, making 50.9% of her shots this season (54-of-106).

With an expanded role on the court, Tarrance has produced, and seeing the success the Lady Cougars have had over the last few years — Grayson County has gone 58-24 over the last three seasons — has been “rewarding” to her. “As the senior on the team,

it’s been so rewarding to see how good we have been doing this season so far, watching everyone grow not only as ballplayers but as people,” she said. “I am the last of 12 seniors that would have been playing this season and being able to see all of the work I’ve put into getting to where I am today as a player has been so rewarding.”

boating and driving. But he said he is willing to work with Fleming on the concerns in hopes of supporting the bill later in the session.

Jeremy Thompson, director of law enforcement for Kentucky Fish and Wildlife Resources, told lawmakers his agency would enforce the bill if enacted.

“We will enforce every law passed by the General Assembly,” Thompson said. HB 168 advanced from committee and now heads to the House floor for consideration.

“From the time Mr. Riherd told us nearly two years ago that he wanted to start to adjust his time commitment and focus primarily on the scoreboard after the transition of our data system to ArbiterSports, we have been very public in both our appreciation of his work and the need for that product to continue,” said KHSAA Commissioner Julian Tackett.

“We deeply love Frank and the great things he has done for the KHSAA, its member school administrators and coaches, and a generation of students, and want that legacy project to continue long into the future. While the future scoreboard may not be identical and could take on a different look or feel, we would not be acting responsibly if we didn’t work to continue this great project. We are committed to the scoreboard continuing in 2026-27 and beyond after Frank steps aside on June 30 this year, and we are forever indebted.”
