On June 20 from 4-7 p.m., come down to historic Grayson Springs for an old fashioned County Homecoming Picnic.

Here's what is in store for the Homecoming:

- Pig Roast: Chef Matt Filip of Toasty's Tavern and the Filip family are roasting the hog, and will sell plate dinners with country sides by Mel's Cafe to benefit Grayson Springs. Guests are also welcome to bring a picnic

basket of their own.

- Kentucky Bluegrass: The event will feature performances by a Bluegrass trio featuring seven-time Kentucky Governor's Cup champion, Joel Whittinghill.

- Family Photos: Organizers have partnered with local photographer Chelsea Lashley for family photo sessions.

- History Hike: Local historian Jason Yeager will lead the historical hike up to a Civil War dugout.

- Civic Life: Rep. Samara Heavrin, R-Leitchfield, will introduce the Grayson Springs Chapter of the Children of the American Revolution Society, who will perform a reenactment of the signing of the Declaration of Independence
