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is 22.72 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. Additionally, a tax of 10 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation on vehicles and watercraft will be levied. According to Clarkson City Clerk Scotty Gore, this rate, which is the same as it was last year, may be decreased but cannot be increased. Gore said tax bills are

expected to be mailed out in mid- to late-October. In other business, the city commission:

- Entered into executive session. After returning to regular session, the commission voted to set Blake Elmore's Clarkson Police Chief pay rate at \$30 per hour and adjust his retirement to have hazardous duty pay. The commission also voted to keep Grayson County Sheriff-elect Buck Meredith hired on as a Clarkson

police officer at his current rate of pay through Dec. 31 or until he resigns to go to the Grayson County Sheriff's Office if he does so before that date.

- Announced that this year's Treats on the Trail will be held Saturday, Oct. 10 from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the Clarkson City Park.
- Set this year's trick-or-treating hours. They will be from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 31.

- Set the registration fee to place a display in the Clarkson Christmas in the Park at \$10. Setups will start Nov. 21 and end on Dec. 3.
- Approved a proclamation naming the month of October 2026 "City Government Month" in Clarkson.
- Heard from Elmore, who said he is going to look into putting the city's ordinances online.

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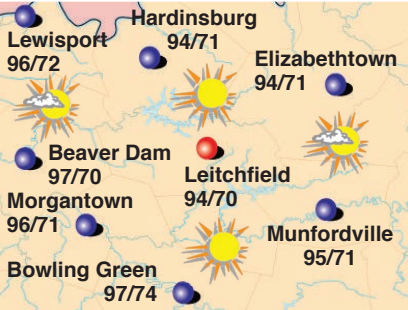

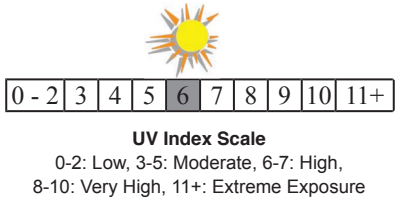

Weather History

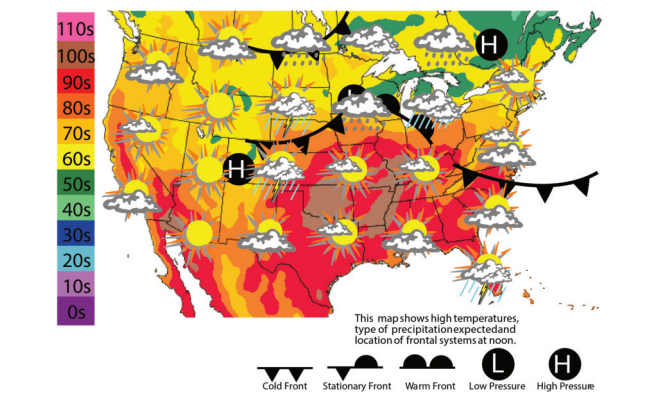
