ORDINANCE 2026-01

An Ordinance creating a handicapped parking space on Main Street in front of the Harrodsburg Eye Center.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Commission that there is a need for a handicapped parking space on Main Street in front of the Harrodsburg Eye Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Harrodsburg, Kentucky that:

There shall be created a handicapped parking space on Main Street in front of the Harrodsburg Eye Center.

Penalties for violation of this ordinance shall be those set forth in Ordinance 1987-06 found at Section 10.99, General Provisions, Harrodsburg City Ordinances. Vehicles violating this Ordinance shall be subject to being towed in addition to the other penalties enumerated herein.

That employees of the City of Harrodsburg shall take appropriate action to mark the handicapped space clearly upon the roadway and to erect a sign demarcating the space.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance was approved by the City Commissioners of Harrodsburg on the 9th day of February, 2026. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
