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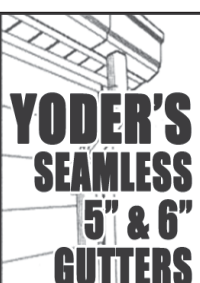
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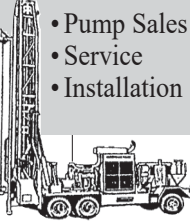
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REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

TITLE
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DATA CENTERS WITHIN THE
CITY OF MUNFORDVILLE.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance 04-2026 establishes regulations for the location, development, construction and operation of Data Centers within the City of Munfordville. The Ordinance is intended to protect the public health, safety and welfare while minimizing impacts on surrounding properties and the City's utilities and infrastructure.

The Ordinance provides that Data Centers may be located only in an industrial Zoning District and only after approval of a Conditional Use Permit. A zoning map amendment and approval by the Munfordville Zoning Board of Adjustment are required.

The Ordinance establishes standards for the location, construction, and operation of Data Centers, including requirements relating to setbacks, building design, access, parking, landscaping, fencing, lighting, noise, utilities, generators, cooling systems, water and wastewater use, environmental impacts, emergency planning, construction traffic, and public infrastructure.

It also requires environmental and community impact analyses as part of the Conditional Use Permit application and requires the applicant to provide financial security so the facility can be properly closed and the site restored if operations cease.

The Ordinance establishes procedures for complaints and authorizes the Munfordville Zoning Board of Adjustment to impose conditions on any Conditional Use Permit and retain consultants at the applicant's expense.
