The blasting site

consists of approximately 2,739.9 acres in Knott, Perry and Breathitt Counties approximately 1.7 miles from the junction of KY 476 and KY 1087.

Blasting will be conducted each day, Monday through Sunday between the hours of sunrise and sunset. The schedule will be in effect for the period from July 2026 through June 2027.

Any major alterations to this blasting schedule will be published. Unscheduled blasts may occur in emergency situations where rain, lightning or other atmospheric conditions for the safety of the or public require unscheduled detonation.

Control of the blasting area will be maintained by blocking access roads to the area prior to the blast. Post detonation access to the blasting area will be allowed only after inspection and determina-

tion that no hazard exists.

Entry to the blasting area will be regulated by signs and barriers. An authorized company representative will prohibit access to the blasting area by unauthorized persons at least ten (10) minutes prior to each detonation. All warning signals will be made by a siren and be audible within a range of one-half mile. The blasting warning will be three (3) long sounds five (5) minutes prior the blast warning signal. The blast warning signal will be a series of short sounds one (1) minute prior to detonation. The all-clear signal will be a series of short sounds one (1) minute prior to detonation. The all-clear signal will be one prolonged sound following inspection of the blasting area.
