rate and programs for beginners, women, veterans, and minorities. Other lenders may provide more timely loans or have fewer eligibility requirements, and may be willing to deal with the extra risk that beginners present, but usually at a higher interest rate to reflect that risk. These lenders would eventually be the "graduation" goal for Farm Service Agency borrowers.
However, land ownership isn't the only way to start a farm business. Renting land is a viable option and can be a lower

cost than ownership. Rental or temporary land access may also open up other options to find land. Vacant urban lots, unused commercial property, or acreages may be creative locations for the opportunity to start farming.
As an example, one persistent beginner located small pasture parcels that larger farmers didn't want to mess with. He sub-rented these parcels, then hauled water, used temporary fencing, and moved his cattle herd from place to place. Landowners noticed his hard work

and care of these properties, and in a few years, offered full farms to him to rent.
