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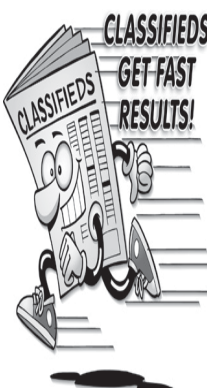

PROPOSAL TAX NOTIFICATION

The Metcalfe County Board of Education is proposing a general fund tax levy of 51.3 cents on real property and 51.3 cents on personal property. This rate is composed of a 51.2 base rate and .1 exonerations.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2026 was 52.2 cents on real property and 52.5 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$3,094,485.38. The proposed General Fund tax rate of 51.3 cents on real property and 51.3 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$3,135,651.34. Of this amount, \$757,673.32 is from new and personal property. The compensating tax for 2027 is 49.3 cents on real property and 49.3 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$3,013,403.72.

The proposed rate is expected to generate more revenue than received in the preceding year. The general area to which revenue of \$41,165.96 above 2026 revenue is to be allocated to is instruction.

This information is published pursuant to KRS 160.470. The proposed tax rate is not subject to recall under KRS 132.017.
