PUBLIC NOTICE**SUMMARY ORDINANCE 73****AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO OPEN BURNING WITHIN THE CITY OF HUSTONVILLE**

Comes John Hackley, City Attorney for the City of Hustonville, and hereby submits the following summary for reading and for publication of Ordinance 73, Open Burning Ordinance.

The Ordinance governs open fires upon any woodlands, lots, subdivision, grasslands, field, or public right-of-way within the city, establishing that no open fires may be allowed unless it is a Class 1 or Class 2 fire day as designated by the Division of Forestry.

On such days that are Class 1 or Class 2 fire days as designated by the Division of Forestry, the Ordinance divides definitions and prohibitions broadly into those in "Residential" areas, and those in "Land-Clearing" areas, such as development and small woodland areas.

The Ordinance specifies what materials may be burned, the hours during which legal open fires may be started, maintenance, observations and safety requirements imposed upon those starting a legal fire, including the equipment or machinery that must be present for prevention of runaway fires. It further establishes appropriate setback requirements for fires relating to structures, fences, property lines, roadways, brush lands or woodlands.

The Ordinance further imposes criminal sanctions for violation of its provisions, as follows:

(j) Penalty. Any person violating any provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court; provided, however, that the court may, in its discretion, suspend any sentence imposed under this section and grant probation to any person convicted of a violation thereof and the court may further, in its discretion, condition such probation and/or suspension of sentence upon reimbursement to the city of any cost and expense suffered or incurred by the city in extinguishing or attempting to extinguish any fire started or had in violation of this section.

This notice shall satisfy a procedural requirement for the activities to be undertaken by Lincoln County.

TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS:

On or about June 4, 2026, Lincoln County will submit a Finding of No Significant Impact to the Department for Local Government for environmental clearance of the Community Development Block Grant under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) and to undertake the proposed project if approved for funding:

Project Name: Lincoln County Donaldson Machine Company CDBG-ED Project

Project Purpose: Community Development Block Grant- Economic Development

The proposed project is intended to support local economic development and workforce expansion through the CDBG ED program. Lincoln County will seek \$200,000 in federal funding for equipment purchase. This will help create 10 jobs at Donaldson Machine Company.

Project will take place within Lincoln County and enhance the local economy by creating additional jobs in the community.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

Lincoln County has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) (PL-91-190) is not required. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) respecting the within project has been made by the Lincoln County which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such a statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the Lincoln County Courthouse, 102 E Main Street, Stanford, Ky 40484 and is available for public examination and copying, upon request, at the Lincoln County Courthouse between the hours of 8 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

All interested agencies, groups, and persons disagreeing with the ERR decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the Judge Executive of Lincoln County to the Lincoln County Courthouse. Such written comments should be received at 102 E Main Street, Stanford, Ky 40484 on or before June 19, 2026. All such comments so received will be considered prior to authorizing submission of the Finding of No Significant Impact or taking any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified on the proceeding sentence.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

Lincoln County will undertake the project described above with Community Development Block Grant funds from the Department for Local Government (DLG) under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

Lincoln County is certifying to the state that the County and Woods Adams, in his official capacity as Judge Executive, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval Lincoln County may use the Community Development Block Grant funds and the state and HUD will have satisfied their responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and related laws and authorities.

PUBLIC NOTICE**ORDINANCE # 75****AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COMMERCIAL DUMPSTERS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS**

NOW BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Hustonville that Ordinance # 75 be as follows.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proper management of commercial waste containers is necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, commercial dumpsters, if improperly placed or maintained, may present safety hazards, obstruct traffic or sidewalks, contribute to environmental pollution, or facilitate illegal dumping; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish regulations governing the placement, use, and maintenance of such dumpsters to ensure compliance with applicable municipal, state, and federal laws;

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to prohibit the use of personal owned dumpsters by city residents and have only dumpsters rented from a commercial waste removal provider.

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

(a) "Commercial Dumpster" means any refuse container, compactor, or storage receptacle used by businesses, industrial facilities, or multifamily residential properties to collect waste materials.

(b) "Owner" means the individual or entity holding legal title to the dumpster or responsible for its placement, maintenance, and use.

(c) "Permit" means the written authorization issued by the City to place a dumpster within the city limits or public right-of-way.

(d) "Public Right of Way" means any street, sidewalk, alley, or other publicly owned property designated for public use.

(e) "Roll-off-dumpsters" are large, mobile containers commonly used for construction, renovation, or major cleanouts.

SECTION 2. PERMIT REQUIREMENT AND DEPOSIT

(a) No person shall place, maintain, or use a commercial dumpster on public property or within a public right-of-way without first obtaining a permit from the City.

(b) The application for a permit/deposit shall include:

(1) The location and dimensions of the dumpster;

(2) Type of waste to be collected;

(3) Duration of placement; and

(4) Acknowledgment of compliance with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations.

(5) Regular dumpster collection may range from weekly to bi-weekly depending on the size of dumpster and the volume of waste produced. All waste must be confined within the dumpster with proper lid closure.

(c) Permits may be issued for temporary or permanent placement in accordance with municipal safety and operational standards.

(d) The cost of the permit will be \$25.00 a year. The deposit fee is \$ 25.00 and will be refundable once the dumpsters are removed.

(e) Permit or Documentation Requirement: Homeowners must provide proof (invoice, contract, or permit) confirming dumpsters are rented from a commercial waste removal provider. (f) Roll-off-dumpsters shall remain in place for no longer than sixty (60) consecutive days. Extensions may be granted by the city upon written request from the property owner, subject to additional permit fees.

SECTION 3. PLACEMENT AND MAINTENANCE.

(a) Dumpsters shall not obstruct sidewalks, fire hydrants, street corners, or emergency access routes.

(b) Dumpsters must be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition with secure lids to prevent spillage, odors, or infestations. To limit the exposure to pest and rainwater lids must remain closed when not adding trash.

(c) Owner must ensure dumpsters are not damaged or leaking; replace rusted or broken containers as needed.

SECTION 4. ACCESS AND USE.

(a) Owners shall ensure that unauthorized access or scavenging is prevented.

(b) No person, other than the owner or authorized personnel, may deposit materials in or remove materials from a commercial dumpster without permission.

SECTION 5. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

(a) Violation of any provision of this ordinance constitutes a municipal offense under KRS 83A.065.

(b) The owner will be notified and be required to sign a notice of violation. The Hustonville Police Chief will deliver the letter.

(c) Penalties for violations will include a fine of \$100 a day. If the dumpster is placed without the required city's approval and removed immediately. If the city has to remove the dumpster it will be at the owner's expense.

(d) Under KRS 83A.065 the City of Hustonville may impose a violation of its ordinance, enforceable through a civil lawsuit if not paid within 5 business days from the notification letter.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
