

Despite Pulisic's absence, US beats Australia 2-0

Team advances to World Cup knockout round

SEATTLE — The U.S. national soccer team advanced to the knockout round at the World Cup despite the absence of injured forward Christian Pulisic, beating Australia 2-0 on Friday.

A deep U.S. roster overcame Pulisic's absence to clinch a knockout berth after only two matches for the first time. The last time the Americans served as World Cup hosts in 1994, they advanced by being

one of the best third-place teams. They then lost to eventual champion Brazil in their next match, which was in the round of 16.

Pulisic, who plays for AC Milan and has 33 goals in 87 international appearances, missed Friday's match because of a calf injury.

Alex Freeman, the youngest player on the team at 21 and son of Super Bowl champion Antonio Freeman, gave the Americans a 2-0 lead in the 43rd minute off a set piece. Freeman headed in a deflected shot by Sergiño Dest for his first

ORDINANCE 2026-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO THE CITY OF PEMBROKE, KENTUCKY ZONING ORDINANCE (ZONING CODE) TO DEFINE AND ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR MANUFACTURED HOMES AND SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLINGS

WHEREAS, the City of Pembroke Commission, by Resolution 2026-2, initiated a zoning text amendment to establish standards for manufactured homes and single-family dwellings and to make other corrections necessary to ensure conformance with House Bill 160 (KRS 100.348, as amended); and
WHEREAS, Community and Development Services held a public hearing on the proposed amendment and made a favorable recommendation at their April 27, 2026 meeting; and
WHEREAS, the Pembroke City Commission concurs with said recommendation and finds the amendment is in agreement with the City of Pembroke Comprehensive Plan.

SUMMARY

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

By summary, the City of Pembroke, Kentucky Zoning Ordinance is amended as follows:

ARTICLE 3 DEFINITIONS

Article 3, Section 3.1 is amended by the Ordinance. The Ordinance retains existing definitions and amends the code to include the following definitions: ANCHORING SYSTEM; MANUFACTURED HOME; MANUFACTURED HOME, NON-QUALIFIED; MANUFACTURED HOME, QUALIFIED; MANUFACTURED HOME PARK; MOBILE HOME; MODULAR HOME; PERMANENT FOUNDATION; ROOF PITCH; SITE-BUILT (STICK-BUILT) DWELLING; and SKIRTING. The Ordinance amends the following definitions: AUTOMOTIVE, MOBILE HOME, TRAVEL TRAILER, FARM IMPLEMENT AND CONSTRUCTION MACHINERY SALES; DWELLING, SINGLE-FAMILY; and DWELLING UNIT.

ARTICLE 5 NONCONFORMITIES

Article 5, Nonconformities, is amended by the Ordinance. The Ordinance amends the article to specify standards for non-conforming mobile homes, non-qualified manufactured homes, and manufactured home parks. The Ordinance creates a new section (Section 5.1 I) to provide standards for the continuance, abandonment, discontinuance, and replacement of nonconforming mobile and manufactured homes and manufactured home parks.

ARTICLE 8 SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

Article 8, Supplemental Regulations, Section 8P (Residential Manufactured/Mobile Housing) is amended by the Ordinance. Section 8P is repealed in its entirety and is replaced by a new Section 8P entitled "Specific Residential Standards." The amended section creates standards for new single-family dwellings, to include site-built, modular, and qualified manufactured homes in the R-1, R-1A, R-2, and R-3 districts. The Ordinance includes orientation, foundation skirting/wall, and roof-pitch requirements for newly constructed or placed single-family homes. The Ordinance provides exceptions and variance eligibility.

APPENDIX A: SCHEDULE OF USES

Appendix A (Schedule of Uses) is amended by the Ordinance to add uses and terminology as shown in the accompanying table and to remove Manufactured Home Subdivision.

All other provision of the Zoning Ordinance and Appendix A remain unaffected by the amendment.
