

# Muhlenberg Achieves expands college access through Free Campus tours for MCHS students



Muhlenberg Achieves is continuing its mission to expand postsecondary opportunities for students at Muhlenberg County High School by providing free college campus tours to juniors and seniors throughout the school year.

During the fall semester, more than 50% of the Class of 2026 participated in visits to the University of Kentucky, University of Louisville, Murray State University, Western Kentucky University, Madisonville Community College's Workforce Solutions, Owensboro Community & Technical College, and Madisonville Community College. These tours

gave students the chance to experience campus life firsthand, explore academic and career pathways, and envision themselves in a postsecondary setting.
