

Amazon's Prime Video dives into college sports with Duke men's basketball

DURHAM, N.C. — Streaming provider Prime Video is diving into college sports by partnering with one of college basketball's biggest brands: Duke. Amazon and Duke announced Thursday they had reached a multiyear agreement to broadcast three of the Blue Devils' neutral-site nonconference matchups per season. This marks the first college partnership for Prime Video, which has aired NFL and

NBA games among other sports. This fall's broadcasts include a Nov. 25 matchup between Duke and UConn in Las Vegas, a rematch of the Huskies' comeback from 19 down to win on a last-second shot in the NCAA Elite Eight. Next is a Dec. 21 matchup against reigning NCAA champion Michigan in New York's Madison Square Garden. Finally, Duke will face Gonzaga on Feb. 20 in Detroit.

Broncos QB Nix expected to be ready for training camp

ENGLEWOOD, Colo. — Bo Nix is still expected to be ready for training camp and the regular season following a cleanup procedure on his right ankle during a scheduled post-operative visit with his surgeon, a person with knowledge of the matter told The Associated Press.


The person spoke on condition of anonymity Thursday because the team isn't releasing details of Nix's cleanup performed by Dr. Norman Waldrop III, who operated on Nix after Denver's quarterback broke a bone in his right ankle on Jan. 18 during the AFC playoffs.

The Broncos will probably be conservative with Nix following the follow-up surgery, which was either going to take place this spring or after next season.

Nix has been working out at the team's suburban Denver headquarters but backup Jarrett Stidham and No. 3 QB Sam Ehlinger will in all likelihood share snaps ahead

of training camp in late July when Nix is expected to return to action.

Other than their rookie minicamp next week, the Broncos have pushed their on-field workouts during OTAs and minicamp to June.

Will LIV players come back to the PGA Tour?

DORAL, Fla. — Jordan Spieth is like everyone else in golf right now. When trying to figure out if LIV golfers who left the PGA Tour will try to return, he doesn't mind saying he has no idea.

"Nobody does. "I think there's just too many unknowns for me to have a good gauge on what would happen," Spieth said Thursday.

The announcement that Saudi Arabia's sovereign wealth fund will stop funding LIV Golf after this year means some of the biggest names in the sport — Jon Rahm, Bryson DeChambeau and Cameron Smith among them — may aim to return to the PGA Tour at some point, much in the same way that Brooks Koepka has and Patrick Reed likely will.

It was, as would be expected, a major talking point at the


Cadillac Championship on Thursday.

"If there's a system for Brooks and a system for Patrick Reed, does that stay the same for guys in the same category as those two coming back or does it change now? Does it change for guys who sued and dropped their membership?" Spieth asked.

DeChambeau, for example, was among players who filed an antitrust lawsuit against the PGA Tour in August 2022. That lawsuit, along with a countersuit by the PGA Tour, was dismissed a year later.

One of the guys who will be in the room — but isn't yet — is newly elected Player Advisory Council chairman Lucas Glover, who begins his four-year term on the board in January. It's


possible that by then, decided will be an after-whatever needs to be thought.

INSPECTION PERIOD FOR THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT ROLL

The Daviess County real property tax roll will be opened for inspection from May 4 through May 19, 2025. (Closed on May 8, 2026). Under the supervision of the Property Valuation Administrator or one of the deputies, any person may inspect the tax roll. This is the January 1, 2026, assessment on which state, county, and school taxes for 2026 will be due.

The tax roll is in the office of the property valuation administrator in the county courthouse and may be inspected between the hours of 8:00 AM– 4:30 PM & Saturday May 9th & 16th between 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM.

Any taxpayer desiring to appeal an assessment on real property made by the PVA must first request a conference with the PVA or a designated deputy. The conference may be held prior to or during the inspection period.

The taxpayer can appeal his/her assessment by filing in person, filing via phone or sending a letter or other written petition stating the reasons for appeal, identifying the property and stating the taxpayer's opinion of the fair cash value of the property.

Any taxpayer still aggrieved by an assessment on real property, after the conference with the PVA or designated deputy, may appeal to the county board of assessment appeals.

The appeal must be filed with the county clerk's office no later than one workday following the conclusion of the inspection period (May 20th, 2026).

A taxpayer failing to appeal to the county board of assessment appeals, or failing to appear before the board, either in person or by designated representative, will not be eligible to appeal directly to the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals.

Appeals of personal property assessments shall not be made to the county board of assessment appeals. Personal property taxpayers shall be served notice under the provisions of KRS 132.450(4) and shall have the protest and appeal rights granted under the provisions of KRS 131.110.

The following steps should be taken when a taxpayer does not agree with the assessed value of personal property as determined by the property valuation administrator.

- (1) He must list under protest (for certification) what he believes to be the fair cash value of his property.
- (2) He must file a written protest directly with the Department of Revenue, Office of Property Valuation within 30 days from the date of the notice of assessment.
- (3) This protest must be in accordance with KRS 131.110
- (4) The final decision of the Department of Revenue may be appealed to the Kentucky Board of Tax Appeals.
