WRITTEN DETERMINATION CONCERNING SURPLUS PROPERTY

The bearings and coordinate value used herein are referenced to the West Virginia State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone.

It is the intent of the foregoing description to include the same land as that described in deed from William Michael Carter and Bobbi Carter, his wife, to Donald Lee Blevins, dated October 13, 1995, filed for record October 13, 1995, and recorded in Deed Book 123, page 334 in the Office of the County Clerk, Martin County, Kentucky. The County obtained the property from Donald Lee Blevins, by deed dated December 17th, 2009 and recorded in Deed Book 173, page 532, in the Office of the Martin County Court Clerk. The intended use at the time of the acquisition of the surplus property was for flood proofing project for the benefit of the Citizens of Martin County, Kentucky. The reasons why conveying the property is in the public's best interest are as follows: The fiscal court is not developing nor does it have plans for this property. Conveying the property to a citizen who could use and maintain the property would be beneficial. The surplus property will be sold subject to any and all restrictions in the chain of title. The property will be sold in its current condition and not subject to any warranties. Any interested buyer has the right to view the property and make his/her own determination of the condition of the property. The method of conveying the surplus property will be sealed bids with bids to be opened at fiscal court meeting. The Court reserves the right to reject any bids or offers that are not deemed in the best interest of the citizens of Martin County. 8,9b
