In accordance with the provisions of KRS 350.055, notice is hereby given that Czar Coal Corporation, 81 Enterprise Drive, Debord, Ken-

tucky 41214 has applied for a major revision to a permit for an surface coal mining and reclamation operation affecting 144.48 acres and will underlie an additional 40.07 acres located approximately 8.7 miles southeast of Odds in Martin County.

The proposed operation is approximately 6.1 miles southeast from KY Route 3's junction with Airport Road, located along the Middle Fork of Rockcastle Creek.. The proposed operation is located on the Thomas and Lancer U.S.G.S. 7-1/2 minute quadrangle map. The operation will use the contour strip, area mining and high-wall/ auger methods of mining. The surface area

to be disturbed is owned by Pocahontas Development Corporation. The operation will underlie surface area owned by Pocahontas Development Corp.
