TODAY IN HISTORY

Today is **Saturday, Feb. 14**, the 45th day of 2026. There are 320 days left in the year. This is Valentine’s Day.

ON THIS DAY IN 1779, English explorer James Cook was killed on the island of Hawaii during a confrontation after Cook’s attempt to kidnap Hawaiian monarch Kalani-ōpu-u as leverage to recover a boat stolen from one of Cook’s ships.

IN 1876, inventors Alexander Graham Bell and Elisha Gray applied separately for patents related to the telephone. The U.S. Supreme Court eventually ruled Bell the rightful inventor.

IN 1929, the “St. Valentine’s Day Massacre” took place in a Chicago garage as seven rivals of Al Capone’s gang were gunned down.

IN 1984, 6-year-old Stormie Jones became the world’s first heart-liver transplant recipient when the surgery was performed at Children’s Hospital of Pittsburgh. The girl died in 1990 at age 13.

IN 2013, double-amputee Olympic sprinter Oscar Pistorius shot and killed his girlfriend, Reeva Steenkamp, at his home in Pretoria, South Africa, saying he mistook her for an intruder. He later was convicted of murder and served nearly nine years of a sentence of 13 years and five

months before being released in January 2024.

IN 2017, a former store clerk, Pedro Hernandez, was convicted in New York of murder, nearly 38 years after 6-year-old Etan Patz disappeared while on the way to a school bus stop.

IN 2018, a former student opened fire with a semiautomatic rifle at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida, killing 17 people. Nikolas Cruz pleaded guilty to murder in October 2021 and was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

IN 2023, President Recep Tayyip Erdogan announced that more than 35,000 people died in Turkey as a result of an earthquake, making it the deadliest such disaster since the country’s founding 100 years earlier. The combined death toll in Turkey and neighboring Syria would

surpass 50,000 people.
