A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the site located at 580 Westport Road in Elizabethtown, Kentucky on August 13, 2026 at 10:00AM EST / 9:00AM CST. A review of the Contract Documents will take place at this meeting and an opportunity to examine the existing building will follow the meeting.

Bid bonds in the amount of 5% of the total bid are required. Performance and payment bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract amount are required of each successful bidder upon execution of their contract.

All contractors and subcontractors employed on this project shall be in compliance with the Commonwealth of Kentucky requirements for Worker's Compensation Insurance (according to KRS 342) and Unemployment Insurance (according to KRS Chapter 341).

Hardin County Board of Health intends to award contracts based upon the best evaluated bid. Hardin County Board of Health reserves the right to accept the bid deemed by it to be in its best interest, not necessarily the least expensive bid; the right to disqualify bids from bidders not deemed to be qualified; the right to disqualify bids deemed to be defective; the right to waive defects on bids where such defects are not deemed significant; and the right to waive any and all formalities and the right to reject any and all bids.
