

Simpson will not return to running

BOULDER, Colo. — World champion runner Jenny Simpson revealed it was a rare heart condition that threw her into cardiac arrest at a race in June and that she will not return to running.

In an Instagram post Thursday, the 39-year-old Simpson said she was

diagnosed with Arrhythmogenic Right Ventricular Cardiomyopathy (ARVC), a condition that triggered “dangerous heart rhythms that ultimately caused my heart to stop.”

She said the diagnosis means it would be dangerous to return to running. “That chapter has ended,” she said.

“Thankfully, my story hasn’t.”

Simpson was pacing a group of girls in a mile run at an event in Raleigh, North Carolina, when she collapsed. She underwent CPR at the track and an automated external defibrillator was also used before medics rushed her to the hospital.

2026 PROPOSED TAX RATE
PUBLIC HEARING

The Hardin County Fiscal Court will hold a public hearing on 8 September 2026 at 3:30 P.M. in the Hardin County Government Center, 150 N. Provident Way, 3rd Floor, Elizabethtown, Kentucky, for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public regarding the proposed tax rate.

The real property tax rate levied last year was 10.8 cents per \$100 of assessed value to potentially produce real property revenue in the amount of \$10,338,595 and the actual revenue produced was \$9,474,286. This year's proposed tax rate of 10.7 cents per \$100 is projected to produce a total of \$10,992,658 in revenue from real property. Included in this amount would be \$237,830 revenue from "new real property" (net increase in the property added to the tax roll for the current year)

This year's compensating rate is 10.3 cents per \$100 of assessed value and would potentially produce total revenue from real property in the amount of \$10,581,718 if adopted. This year's 4% growth rate would be 10.7 cents per \$100.00 of assessed value (the same rate proposed) and would potentially produce total revenue from real property in the amount of \$10,992,658.

The proposed rate for Personal Property, Business Inventory, Documented/Non KY Registered Watercraft and Aircraft is 12.3 cents per \$100 of assessed value with potential revenue from Personal Property of \$1,304,324; Motor Vehicle and Watercraft, remains unchanged at the current rate of 11.5 cents per \$100 of assessed value with revenue potential from Motor Vehicle to be \$1,308,793; revenue potential from Watercraft is \$30,975.

Revenue received in excess of last year's revenue will be used for general government expenditures.

Per Ordinance No. 337, Series 2023, the Industrial Taxing District Ad Valorem Tax Rate is ten cents (\$.10) per one hundred dollars (\$100) of the assessed valuation of the Commercial and Telecommunications parcels within the district.

Presentation of testimony per KRS 65A100 relating proposed taxes will be provided by the following: Hardin County Extension Service; Hardin County Health Department and Hardin County Conservation District.

Public Notice Regarding Confidentiality and Child Find for Children with Disabilities in Need of Special Education, 504 Services, or Preschool Services

Child Find
Elizabethtown Independent Schools (EIS) keeps education records in a secure location in each school and Board office.

EIS obtains written consent from a parent or eligible student (age 18 or who is attending a postsecondary institution), before disclosing personally identifiable information to an entity or individual not authorized to receive it under FERPA.

For students who have been determined eligible for Special Education, educational records will be destroyed at the request of the parents when they are no longer needed to provide educational programs or services. EIS may destroy the educational records of a child without parent request three years after they are no longer needed to provide educational programs or services. Parents are advised that data contained in the records may later be needed for Social Security benefits or other purposes. EIS may retain, for an indefinite period of time, a record of the student's name, address, telephone number, grades, attendance records, classes attended, grade level completed, and year completed.

Children eligible for Special Education include those with disabilities who have autism, deaf-blindness, developmental delay, emotional-behavior disability, hearing impairment, mental disability, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, or visual impairment and who because of such an impairment need Special Education services.

Children eligible for 504 services include those children in a public elementary and secondary education program who have a current physical or mental impairment that currently substantially limits some major life activity, which causes the student's ability to access the school environment or school activities to be substantially limited.

Children eligible for the State-Funded Preschool program include three and four-year-old children who are at-risk, as defined by federal poverty levels up to 150%. Preschool children eligible for special education must have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) instead of a 504 plan to receive State-Funded Preschool program services. EIS has an ongoing "Child Find" system, which is designed to locate, identify and evaluate any child residing in a home, facility, or residence within its geographical boundaries, age 3-21 years who may have a disability and require Special Education or 504 services. This includes children who are not in school; those who are in public, private, or home school; those who are highly mobile such as children who are migrant or homeless; and those who are advancing from grade to grade, who may need but are not receiving Special Education or 504 services.

EIS "Child Find" system includes children with disabilities attending private or home schools within the school district boundaries who may need special education services.

EIS will make sure any child enrolled in its district who qualifies for Special Education or 504 services, regardless of how severe the disability, is provided appropriate Special Education or 504 services at no cost to the parents of the child.

Parents, relatives, public and private agency employees, and concerned citizens are urged to help EIS find any child who may have a disability and Special Education or 504 services. The District needs to know the name and age, or date of birth of the child; the name, address, and phone number(s) of the parents or guardian; the possible disability; and other information to determine if Special Education and 504 services are needed.

Letters and phone calls are some of the ways EIS collects the information needed. The information the school district collects will be used to contact the parents of the child and find out if the child needs to be evaluated or referred for Special Education or 504 services.

"Child Find" activities will continue throughout the school year. As a part of these efforts, EIS will use screening information, student records, and basic assessment information it collects on all children in the district to help locate those children who have a disability and need Special Education or 504 services. Any information the district collects through "Child Find" is maintained confidentially. Written Policies and Procedures have been developed which describe the district's requirements regarding the confidentiality of personally identifiable information and "Child Find" activities. There are copies in the Principal's office of each school and the Board of Education office.

The district office is open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

EIS provides a public notice in the native language or other mode of communication of the various populations in the geographical boundaries of the district to the extent feasible. If you know of someone who may need this notice translated to another language, given orally, or delivered in some other manner or mode of communication, please contact the Director of Special Programs at the address or phone number listed above for EIS.
