Campbellsville Taylor County Economic Development Authority (CTCEDA) will be accepting bids for "Heartland Commerce and Technology Park: Industrial Property Farm Lease". Bids will be received through 10:00 AM, ET, on Thursday, February 26, 2026, and at this time they will be opened and publicly read. Only sealed bids will be accepted. Bids should be addressed to CTCEDA, 205 North Columbia Avenue, Campbellsville, KY 42718, Attn: Ron McMahan.

The bid is for leasing the 203 acre (25 - 35 tillable acres) industrial property located at 2100 New Columbia Road, Campbellsville, KY. The term of the lease shall be for crop years 2026 and 2027. The lease will be for growing all crops except corn. No livestock will be allowed. The tillable acreage not cropped shall be mowed twice a year, in June and October, with a bat wing rotary mower for a presentable finish. If CTCEDA sells, transfers, or develops a portion of the tillable acreage then it shall receive from the lessee a prorated share of the lease payment, as initially bid, for the remaining portion of the property the Lessee can continue to use.
