

# MWPD provides a glimpse into police life

WASHINGTON — The police will once again show the community what it's really like to protect and serve.

The Mount Washington Police Department will hold a free Citizens Police Academy training course for the community beginning Feb. 10.

Last year's initial training went so well, police chief Dan Kelty said this year's course was extended from six weeks to eight.

"This was developed to give the community a better idea

of what we do as police officers," he said. "We extended it to eight weeks because last year everybody wished it lasted longer."

According to Kelty, the program will include a field trip to the Bullitt County Detention Center, where jailer Bryan Whittaker will provide a tour and discuss the police officers' process at the facility.

Other nights will include visits from community officials such as Bullitt District Court Judge Jennifer Porter and State Rep. Peyton Griffey, who will discuss laws and legal procedures.

Other nights will involve simulator trainings and mock

traffic stops, allowing participants to experience firsthand what officers are dealing with in certain situations.

"We go through the whole process," said Kelty. "From the arrest, to jail, to court, we show them everything."

Participants must be at least aged 18 years and up. Last year's class included 13 participants ranging in age from 19 to 70. Kelty said the 19-

year-old participated to prepare for future training with the Louisville Metro Police Department.

"They all just wanted to learn more about policing," Kelty said. "They wanted to see what it's like to be one."

Kelty added that the program allows MWPD officers

an opportunity to meet with individuals and discuss their jobs. He mentioned that a K-9 unit would also participate in the program.

Courses will take place every Tuesday night, 6-8 pm, at the Mount Washington Training

Center, 358 Evans Lane.
