Reds' ace Hunter Greene could miss up to 4 months following right elbow surgery

GOODYEAR, Ariz. — Cincinnati Reds' ace Hunter Greene is scheduled to undergo surgery Wednesday on his right elbow and could miss up to the first four months of the season.

The Reds said Greene was diagnosed with bone chips and loose bodies in his elbow. Greene needed an MRI last week after he left spring training camp due to right elbow stiffness.

Greene went 7-4 with a 2.76 ERA last year, helping Cincinnati earn an NL wild card for its first playoff appearance since 2020.

Greene, whose 99.5 mph average four-seam fastball velocity led the major leagues

among those throwing at least 1,250 pitches, was limited to a career-low 19 starts and 107 2/3 innings. Still, his 296 pitches of 100 mph or higher were second in the major leagues behind Mason Miller's 422.

Greene was placed on the 15-day injured list on May 9 with a right groin strain. He returned on May 23 and made three starts before going back on the IL with the same injury. This time, he was sidelined until Aug. 13.

The 26-year-old Greene is entering his fifth big league season. He made the NL All-Star team for the first time in 2024 while going 9-5 with a 2.75 ERA in 26 starts. He also had 169 strikeouts in 150 1/3 innings despite spending time on the IL that year with elbow soreness.

In the high jump, where she finished second a year ago, Sutherland was one of three competitors who cleared 5-4. Based on fewer misses in the run-up to that height, Sutherland was crowned the state champion. Also clearing 5-4 were Oldham County senior Aubrelle Neal and South Oldham junior Chloe Quinn, the defending champion, who had cleared 5-06.25 a year ago.

Another Bullitt East athlete who is well known is senior Savannah Mooney, who scored six team points when she finished third in the 1,600-run. This was a close finish as the top four runners were all within two-and-a-half seconds of each other. North Oldham senior Elle

Cargould won the race in 5:07.47 while Sacred Heart freshman Lucy Gaunt was second in 5:07.78. Mooney was just behind those two in 5:09.66 just edging out Madison Central senior Shelby Lamb who was fourth in 5:09.78. No other runners in the field bettered 5:12.

With the outdoor track season still ahead, Mooney has already competed in the state soccer tournament and state cross-country championships along with the indoor state track finals.

A newer name on the local track scene is Bullitt East freshman Emmy Crepps, who was one of the state's top middle school long jumpers the past two seasons. She carried that right into the high school division on Wednesday when she finished third in the long jump.

Crepps had a very impressive leap of 16-11 as

her best effort, but that was well off the pace set by the top two finishers. The win went to Simon Kenton senior Alexis Howard with a state record leap of 18-07.25. The runner-up was South Oldham senior Elle Gilbert at 18-02.50.

Crepps leap of 16-11 barely eclipsed the 16-10.75 of fourth-place finisher Sophia Shenk of North Oldham.

North Bullitt freshman Zariah Taylor was also in the long jump and finished 22nd with a leap of 13-10.50.

Crepps also competed in the 200-meter dash. The freshman posted a time of 27.01 to finish 15th.

Also competing in the state championships was North Bullitt junior Jayda Fiske in the triple jump. Fiske's best leap at 30-01.00 and that placed her 18th overall.

HOKE SCORES FOR NB
The only Bullitt County

male to compete in the indoor track state championships was North Bullitt senior Micah Hoke.

Hoke's best finish was in the 400-meter dash as the senior finished in a time of 50.38, placing him second in his heat and fifth-overall. The winning time was a 48.70 by South Warren senior Luke Roner.

The finish by Hoke gave North Bullitt four team points. Those points placed North Bullitt in a tie for 32nd on the day.

Hoke also had a strong showing in the 200-meter dash. The senior finished second in his heat in a time of 22.83 to finish tenth. The winning time was a 21.62 by Frederick Douglass junior Kaden John.

In a diverse set of events, Hoke also competed in the 55-meter dash. He finished second in the middle of the three heats in a time of 6.67.

Overall, that placed him 13th overall.

In such a short event, the top times were very close. Hoke's time was only .27 of a second off the winning time of 6.40 by Frederick Douglass junior John Kaden.

ORDINANCE 2025-06

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SOLICITING WITHIN THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, there has been an increase in the number and frequency of uninvited solicitations within the City of Hebron Estates, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Hebron Estates have voiced complaints to the City Commission about these uninvited solicitations disrupting their daily activities, and

WHEREAS, some of these solicitations are frightening to some of the elderly residents of the City, and have resulted in allegations of intimidation, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission believes for the public safety and welfare of City residents a prohibition of individual involved in door to door solicitation is necessary, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES, as follows:

SECTION ONE: DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following words as used herein shall be considered to have the meaning herein ascribed thereto:

- "Soliciting"** shall mean and include any one or more of the following activities:
 - An offer to pay or accept money in exchange for sex; or
 - Seeking to obtain orders for the purchase of goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, cable/dish services, television services, internet service of any kind, character or description whatever, for any kind of consideration whatever; or
 - Seeking to obtain prospective customers for application or purchase of insurance of any type, kind of character; or
 - Seeking to obtain subscriptions to books, magazines, periodicals, newspapers, and every other type of kind of publication.
- Solicitor:**
 - A person who seeks business or contributions from others; an advertiser or promoter;
 - A person who conducts matters on another's behalf; an agent or representative.
- "Residence"** shall mean and include every separate living unit occupied for residential purposes by one or more persons, contained within any type of building or structure.

SECTION TWO: DUTY OF SOLICITORS.
Any solicitor who has gained entrance to any residence, whether invited or not, shall immediately and peacefully depart from the premises when requested to do so by the occupant.

SECTION THREE: SOLICITING PROHIBITED.
It is hereby declared to be unlawful and shall constitute a nuisance for any person to go upon any premises and ring the door bell upon or near any door, or create any sound in any other manner calculated to attract the attention of the occupant of such resident, for the purpose of securing an audience with the occupant thereof and engage in soliciting as herein defined.

SECTION FOUR: EXCEPTIONS.
The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to officers or employees of the city, county, state or federal government.

SECTION FIVE:
Appropriate signs and markings shall be erected and posted at the intersection of:

Lodie Drive/Old Hwy. 61
North Preston Hwy./at Cut Thru to Old Hwy. 61
Burkland Blvd./Old Hwy 61
Willow Way/Old Hwy. 61
E. Hebron Lane/Old Hwy. 61
Grissom Drive/Old Hwy. 61
Grider Drive/Old Hwy. 61
Robin Way/Paula Drive

notifying the general public that solicitation shall not be permitted within the municipal boundaries of the City of Hebron Estates.

SECTION SIX: PENALTY.
Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each offense.

SECTION SEVEN: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication and the posting of signage described in Section Five hereinbefore.

SECTION EIGHT: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION NINE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
