PUBLIC NOTICE

Listing Period

January 1, 2026 through March 1, 2026 is the Listing Period for Real Property and January 1, 2026 through May 15, 2026 for Tangible Property.

Real Property Additions/Deletions

Any taxpayer who has made physical changes to or added new property would need to report this to the local Property Valuation Office. Likewise, any property which has suffered damage or has been removed would need to be reported. These are changes which would have occurred between January 1, 2025 and January 1, 2026.

Address Corrections

Anyone who has not submitted a change of address form with their 2025 Tax Bills or has a PO Box not listed on their 2025 Tax Bills would need to report this Address Correction.

Homestead Exemption

Any person who turned 65 years of age in 2025 or will be 65 years of age in 2026 that has title to, lives in, and maintains their personal residence would need to stop by the Property Valuation Office or call to sign up for their Homestead Exemption. If you have already signed up there is no need to call or fill out another application.

Tangible Property

All individuals, partnerships, corporations, and other business entities owning, leasing, or having a beneficial interest in taxable tangible property which is located in Kentucky on January 1 must file a Tangible Property Tax Return. This would include items such as Manufacturing Machinery, Office Equipment, Inventory, etc. Forms may be obtained from our website in *.pdf or *.xls format:
