God Knows You

There Is Nothing God Can't Do!

Q: I believe God is all-knowing, all-present and all-powerful. Intellectually I know God can do everything, but practically I often act as if God can't do anything. How can I more closely align what I do every day with what I believe?

A: Our all-powerful, all-present, all all-knowing God could have chosen to remain aloof and distant from our lives. Instead, He works on behalf of His children. In Isaiah 44, the prophet gives us three imperatives to align our lives with His existence:

Remember. God calls His children (Christians) to remember their identity in relation to Him. "Remember these things, Jacob, and Israel, for you are my servant: I formed you . .

. I have swept away your transgressions . . ." (Is. 44:21, 22).

Return. God urges His children to "return to me, for I have redeemed you" (Is. 44:22). Spiritually, we need to repent and stay close to God because our heavenly Father has given His Son to redeem us.

Rejoice. God spoke through His prophet Isaiah saying, "Rejoice, heavens, for the LORD has acted; shout, depths of the earth. Break out into singing . . ." (Is. 44:23). Let's sing because God acts on behalf of His children.

God can do anything and He is working to turn things ou good for His children (Rom. 8:28). Therefore, let us daily acknowledge His presence, depend on His power and submit to His leading.

Did You Know?
