# Board Of Education Meets For Monthly Work Session

The Union County Board of Education met for their monthly work session on Thursday, June 18 with Superintendent Dr. Terra Hancock and three board members – Chad Hagan, Jennifer Buckman, and Greg Clifton present. Board members Donnie Gatten and Susan Duncan participated in the meeting via Zoom and Facetime.

In a session that lasted about an hour, the members held first reading for the proposed policy and procedure changes for the 2026-2027 school year. Those changes are recommended annually by the Kentucky School Boards Association, and local boards of education are required each year to conduct a review of local policies in order to be aligned with state mandates. Any changes must be made each year by August 15; however, the Union County Board of Education makes the changes each June.

On Wednesday, Evan Jackson, Assistant Superintendent of Public Relations, reviewed about two dozen changes recommended by KSBA. Those recommendations include changes in the powers and duties of the board of education; organizational meetings; time change requirements for all meetings; in-service training; the contract for the superintendent; school budget and purchasing; hiring; salaries; transfers; use of school property; political activities; professional and staff development; fiscal management; authority to encumber and expend funds; district accounts; model procurement code purchasing; financial statements and reports; safety; weapons; bus scheduling and routing; competitive foods; school nutrition procurement; curriculum; dyslexia; writing program; religious beliefs excusal; access to electronic media; traceable communications; admissions and attendance; employee reports of criminal activity; assault and threats of violence; child abuse; student activities; and expulsion.

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Board members held second reading of the proposed policy and procedure changes; and once approved, those changes will be implemented and included in the local district policy and procedure handbook.

In other business, the board members reviewed the agenda for the regular meeting which was held on Monday night. No further business came before the board of education, and the meeting was adjourned.
