At 35 years old, Griggs was firmly established in his career as the superintendent of the Henderson County Mine. Yet, a deeper calling remained. Driven by a lifelong passion for aviation and a profound desire to serve his country, Griggs, with the support of his devoted wife, made the brave decision to step out of his comfort zone and reach for the skies.

Today, his community is celebrating him not just for taking that leap, but for conquering it.

On September 1st, Warrant Officer Griggs graduated from the rigorous Warrant Officer Candidate School (WOCS) at Fort Rucker, Alabama, leaving an unforgettable mark on his unit. He finished the grueling program as an Honor Graduate and claimed the highly coveted “IRON WOC” award—an honor reserved strictly for the single candidate who achieves the absolute highest score across all graded physical training events.

The achievement is a testament to the grit and determination familiar to those who worked with him in the local tri-county area. Griggs, who holds a professional engineering license, private pilot’s license, and recently added his helicopter rating, spent a full year navigating tests and administrative hurdles to prove he has what it takes.

His journey officially began on April 27th, when he shipped out for Army Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. Graduating on July 9th, he immediately reported to Fort Rucker, Alabama pushing through weeks of intense mental and physical evaluation to earn his Warrant Officer rank.

Warrant Officer Griggs and his wife, Carrie, are currently stationed at Fort Rucker, where he is set to begin elite flight training at the U.S. Army Aviation Center of Excellence.

From managing operations at the local mine to setting physical fitness records for the United States Army, Levi Griggs embodies the very best of our community. Henderson and Union counties are proud to call him one of our own and look forward to watching him soar in service to our country.
