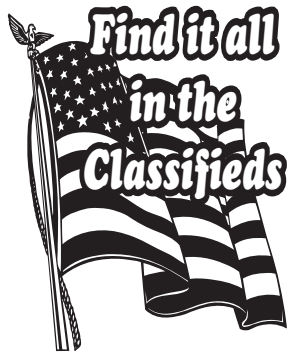

The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from the City of Eddyville to construct a new wastewater treatment plant and extend wastewater service to the Eddyville Riverport in Eddyville, Lyon County, Kentucky. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is conducting an assessment of the potential of the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties.

Notice is hereby given that the project is proposed to be located in, or may affect, a floodplain and/or wetland as defined by Executive Order (EO) 11988 and/or EO 11990. The project his project will replace the failed wastewater treatment system and establish a long-term solution for treatment of the City's wastewater well into the future with a more sustainable, robust system. This new system will be capable of handling current loadings, as well as anticipated future loadings from neighboring municipalities, commercial, industrial, and Riverport developments in the region. In addition to the wastewater plant replacement, the scope of work planned for this project includes the expansion of the City's sanitary sewer system to include the currently non-sewered Eddyville Riverport with an extension to the KY State Penitentiary (KSP), which has an aged treatment system that is nearing the end of its intended useful lifecycle. Regarding the sewer system expansion, this work shall include the planning, design, permitting, procurement, and construction of 2 new wastewater lift stations and high-density polyethylene force mains, which will extend from the KSP site north to the City's existing KY-93 lift station. This project will also include upgrades to the existing KY-93 lift station to handle the additional flows for processing and conveyance to the new wastewater treatment plant facilities. Project information is available for review at the Pennyville Area Development District, 300 Hammond Drive, Hopkinsville, Kentucky, 42240.


