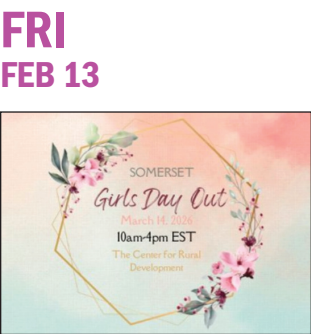

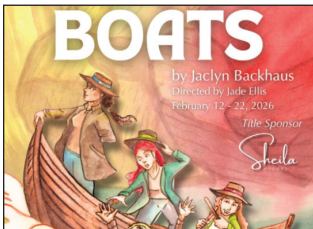

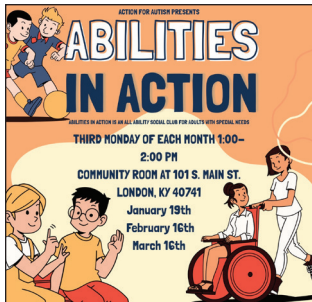
**Lighthouse Kids Crew**
