Ballou to serve as Judge on the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky,” Trump stated in the announcement. Ballou currently serves as circuit judge for Whitley and McCreary counties. He was elected to the position in 2006 — having served a prior four-year term as District Judge — and has subsequently been re-elected without opposi-

tion.

According to Trump’s announce- ment, Ballou earned his bache- lor’s degree from the University of Kentucky and his law degree from the University of Mississippi School of Law. He previously served as a law clerk for Judge Eugene Siler of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. Ballou is also a U.S. Marine Corps veteran. Trump said he believes Ballou would be a “pow- erful defender of the Rule of Law” on the federal bench.

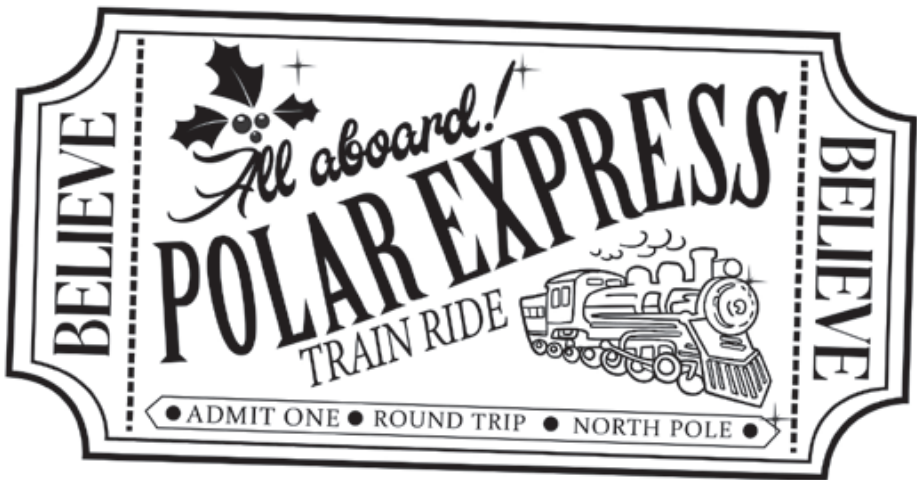

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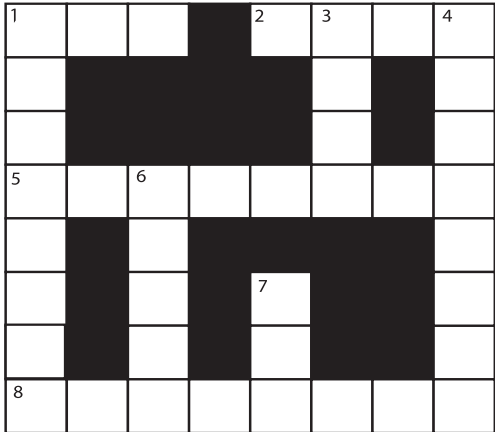
