

# DISTRICT COURT

According to public records of the Monroe District Court, the following action was taken recently. Name in parentheses is the arresting officer or complaining witness. Numbers in parentheses given of the birth year of the accused. "Commonwealth" refers to the county attorney and other law enforcement officers.

April 14, 2026

Julie Ann Gearlds (DOB 1980) had her arraignment for a charge of operating a motor vehicle under the influence of a controlled substance (second) continued to June 26.

William W. Muse (DOB 1958) pled not guilty at his arraignment on charges of driving on a suspended license (first offense) and operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol (second) and a pretrial conference has been set for May 26.

Jessica Watson (DOB 1987) had her bond hearing for charges of excessive windshield/window tinting, driving DUI suspended license (first offense, aggravator) and operating a motor vehicle under the influence of a controlled substance continued to June 23.

Robert Ely Brooks had his arraignment for a charge of speeding (10 mph, school zone) entered the deferral program and was referred to the traffic safety program.

amine).

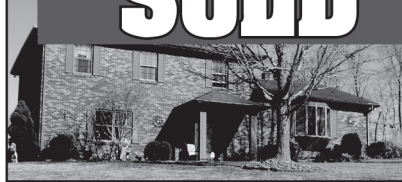
