ORDINANCE UPDATING PAY/CLASSIFICATION PLAN
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Carrollton recognizes that the city’s pay/classification plan must be updated from time to time in order to remain current and to maintain an effective and efficient work force;
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council, City of Carrollton, Commonwealth of Kentucky:
(1) That the authorized positions and assigned grade be revised as follows:
