FLOODPLAIN AND WETLAND NOTICE OF EXPLANATION ACTIVITY IN A 100-YEAR FLOODPLAIN

DATE: 03/20/2026

To: All interested Agencies, Federal, State, and Local Groups and Individuals

The City of Campton, under 24 CFR Part 58, has conducted an evaluation in accordance with Executive Orders 11988 and 11990 and 24 CFR 55.20 to determine the potential effect that its project in the floodplain may have on the human environment.

The Campton Sewer Rehabilitation project consists of rehabilitation of portions of the existing sanitary sewer system within the City of Campton, Wolfe County, Kentucky to reduce infiltration and inflow and improve system reliability. Work will include approximately 9,953 LF of cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) lining for 8-inch sewer, sewer cleaning and CCTV inspection, 16 mainline spot repairs, 95 service lateral repairs, and rehabilitation of 68 manholes. The project will also include pump and control upgrades at two lift stations, including the plant influent station, and installation of a new PLC-based control system at the wastewater treatment plant.

Most work will occur within existing streets and previously disturbed areas, using trenchless methods to minimize surface disturbance.

Alternatives considered included full replacement of the sewer lines using open-cut trenching, which would require extensive excavation and pavement replacement within streets and the business district and would be cost prohibitive, and the no-action alternative, which would allow continued deterioration of the sewer system and increased maintenance costs, service disruptions, and public health risks.

Portions of the project may occur within the 100-year floodplain. Because the work involves rehabilitation of existing underground infrastructure within developed areas, the project will not obstruct flood flows or alter floodplain storage.

The City of Campton has determined there is no practicable alternative to completing the work within the floodplain.

Environmental review records documenting compliance with Executive Orders 11988 and 11990 are available for public review upon request.
