## Be Safe This Summer

### Use Your Grill Safety

To make sure your family outings remain happy and fun this summer, follow these fire safety tips.

- Always keep a 3-foot radius clear around the grill and designate the area where the grill is as a no play zone for children and pets.
- Before grilling, position your grill away from the house, deck railing, overhanging eaves, or tree branches. Propane and charcoal grills are for outdoor use only. If used inside, they could expose your family to toxic carbon monoxide as well as pose a serious fire risk.
- Do not wear loose fitting clothing while grilling. If your clothes do catch on fire do remember to Stop, Drop and Roll.
- Always use long handled grilling tools so your hands stay far away from the flame. And never leave a lit grill unattended, especially a Charcoal Grill. Only use proper starter fluid on your charcoal grill and store it out of the reach of children.
- Never add lighter fluid to hot coals. Keep matches and

lighters out of the reach of children and teach them to tell an adult if they see matches or lighters.

- Properly dispose of hot coals by dousing them in water and stirring to ensure that the fire is completely out. Always use a metal container to dispose of coal or ashes.
- Especially for propane grills, always check the connection between the propane tank and the fuel line. Make sure the tubes are not blocked and that the hose is not leaking. To check for leaks, apply a light soap and water mixture to the hose. If bubbles start to form, you have a leak. If this happens and there is no flame, turn off the gas tank and the grill and do not use it again until your grill is serviced by a professional. If the leak does not stop after turning the tank off, call the fire department. Also, if you ever smell gas while cooking, move away from the grill immediately and call the fire department; do not try to move the grill.

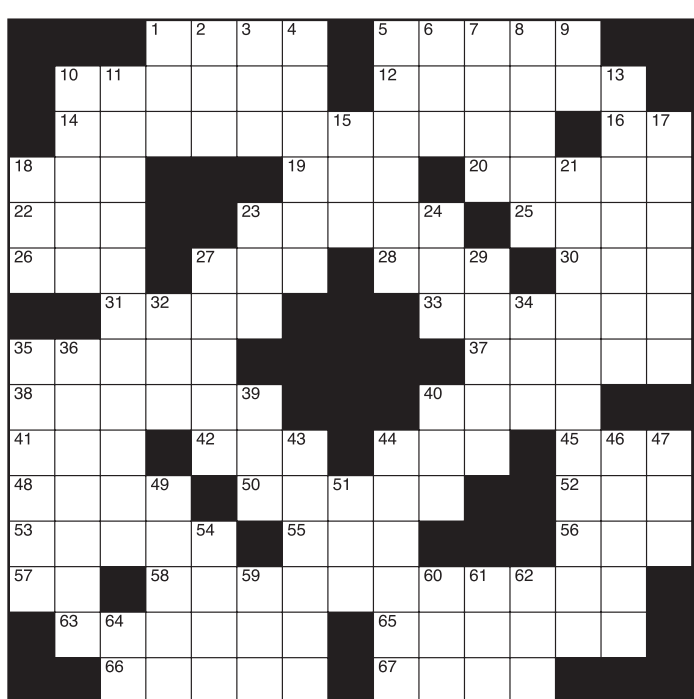
