ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance Relating to the Amendment of the Budget for the City of Campton for Fiscal Year 2025-2026

WHEREAS, KRS Chapter 91A requires that each Municipality accept a budget for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Campton, Wolfe County, Kentucky has previously adopted a budget for fiscal year 2025-2026, as a proposed plan for raising and spending money for specified programs, functions, activities or objectives during the fiscal year so as to provide for efficient financial administration, and

WHEREAS, the City of Campton has received an ARC grant in the amount of \$2,550,000 in connection with the City of Campton- KY waterline Replacement Phase 1 Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Campton desires to document said transfer and to amend the 2025-2026 budget to show the inclusion of said funds into the budget and the expenditure of said funds from the budget,

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CAMPTON CITY COUNCIL, WOLFE COUNTY KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The budget of the City of Campton for fiscal year 2025-2026 is hereby amended to allow for the inclusion into the budget for the City of Campton of a \$2,550,000 ARC grant, received in connection with the City of Campton KY 715 Waterline Replacement Phase 1 project

Section 2. That the budget for the City of Campton for fiscal year 2025-2026 is hereby amended to allow for the expenditure of the aforementioned \$5,650,000 in Kentucky Infrastructure Authority State Revolving Funds Fund F loan funds for use on the City of Campton KY 715 Waterline Replacement Phase 1 Project.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect following its passage and upon publication

Hoedown Island synonymous with the name of the late Richard Jett

Richard Jett Memorial Hoedown slated at Natural Bridge Sept. 26

Hoedown Island at Natural Bridge State Resort Park in Slade, Kentucky, has served as a cultural hub for traditional Appalachian square dancing and clogging for generations. Originally emerging from the region's late-19th century railway tourism and the park's establishment in 1926, the outdoor dance platform has hosted Saturday night community dances and historic preservation events from May through October for over 50 years.
Richard Jett from Wolfe County was the defining figure of Hoedown Island, serving as its original coordinator, master of ceremonies, and primary dance caller for over 40 years. Known as "Ole Richard," he is widely credited with establishing the weekly Saturday night dance programs that transformed Natural Bridge State Resort Park into the "clogging capital of Kentucky."

Jett will be memorialized Saturday, Sept. 26, during a celebration of Hoedown Island's history and tradition with a special dance in his honor. The Richard Jett Memorial Hoedown will start at 4:00 p.m. Former park employees, cloggers, dancers, and community partners will be recognized, exhibits, photos and stories celebrating the rich history of Natural Bridge State Park will be featured along with a special tribute to Richard Jett and his impact on the park and the community.
The Clogging Pioneer, Jett, managed the events on the large outdoor pad every Friday and Saturday night, introducing generations of tourists and locals to traditional Appalachian folk dance. By the spring of 2006, he had emceed his 1,750th program on the island. In 1971,
Jett co-authored Square Dancing in the Mountains of Eastern Kentucky, a foundational booklet preserving

complex regional routines like the Kentucky Running Set and the Big Set. To ensure families could dance at home, he recorded and released instructional vinyl LPs, including Kentucky Mountain Square Dancing. Jett utilized Hoedown Island to showcase local bluegrass musicians and young singers, famously sponsoring traveling youth performance teams like Kentucky Bluegrass Cloggers.
Beyond the dance platform, Jett was a massive civic force in neighboring Wolfe County, where he spent decades working as an educator, eventually serving as the Superintendent of Wolfe County Schools. He was also elected Mayor of Campton. In a poetic end to a life dedicated to regional tradition, Jett passed away doing what he loved while dancing on Hoedown Island at the age of 73 on August 25, 2006. Before his death, Jett passed his calling torch to his apprentice, Jane Bolin, who has sustained his tradition nearly two decades since.

Household Hints

✓Place a cup of white vinegar in the dishwahr and run it for a cycle (without dishes) to help eliminate (hard) water stains. Repeat if deemed necessary.
✓Dissolve tarnish on silver pieces with sour milk. Coat the silver piece with sour milk and wipe off with a dry soft cloth. Reportedly, the lactic acid in sour milk will dissolve tarnish.
✓To dissolve hard water

stains and deposits on water faucets, spray lemon juice on the fixtures, let sit for 1-2 minutes and wipe dry.. Repeat if necessary.
✓To remove coffee or other SET stains on 100% cotton fabric, mix 2 teaspoons 3% Hydrogen Peroxide, 1 teaspoon baking soda, and 1 teaspoon dish soap into a paste substance; apply to stain area for 10 minutes; rinse in cold water; repeat if necessary until stain disappear; and, launder as usual. For 100% polyester fabric, use the same formula,

but soak for 5 minutes. Repeat if necessary.. CAUTION; DO NOT USE ON COLORED FABRIC.SINCE PEROXIDE WILL BLEACH COLORS.
✓A small ceramic bowl or open plastic container of white vinegar placed in an open area of the clothes and shoe closet will help to eliminate musty odors and, more especially, smelly shoe odors.
