to expose his children to the world. Visiting extended family in Maryland exposed her to people who looked like her, people who were attorneys. Coming home to attend law school was an opportunity for her to become that black attorney whom she didn't know growing up, she says.

With her mom's encouragement, Stepp became an attorney and teacher. So, in addition to being an attorney representing the University of Kentucky, she earned a master's degree in education and teaches litigation skills at the law school, she says.

It was also her mom who "encouraged my brother and I to question things," says Stepp.

Now, as the first African American woman to serve as chair of the Planning Commission, Stepps says she wants "my nieces and nephews to know that they can do this."
