In order to comply with the orders of the Russell Circuit Court, the Master Commissioner of the Russell Circuit Court shall proceed to offer for sale to the highest and best bidder at public auction the below properties on **Friday, February 20, 2026, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., CT, Russell District Courtroom, Russell County Judicial Center, Jamestown, Kentucky.**

Said properties shall be sold to raise the amounts hereinafter set forth, together with interest and the costs of the action, and upon (unless otherwise indicated) the following terms and conditions:

A) For the purchase price, the Purchaser(s) must pay in full by cash or good check on the date of sale or the Purchaser(s) may pay ten (10%) down on the day of sale and shall execute a good and sufficient purchase money bond, with approved surety thereon, equal to the balance of the purchase price payable to the Master Commissioner within thirty (30) days. Any such purchase money bond shall have the force and effect of a Judgment and shall be a lien upon the property sold as additional security for the payment of the balance of the purchase price. 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Easily accessible from all directions, Java Springs, now part of The Kentucky Coffee Trail, is conveniently-located just off U.S. 127 at 23 Bernard Lane in Russell Springs.

Behind the scenes, literally, owner Sheri Foster is at a desk covered in mementos and stacks of papers to review.

Amongst all the activity, she sits with a special reason to celebrate.

Her unique business, just over four years old, is sure to see even more success as one of the newest stops along The Kentucky Coffee Trail.

"This is something we are really excited about," she said.

The Kentucky Coffee Trail consists of over 50 coffee shops across the Commonwealth.

"They only pick so many in each region," Foster said. "And from what I understand, people got online and recommended we be put on the list. We are extremely grateful for the fact people went to the trouble to put our name out there...and help us achieve this honor."

Foster said she is particularly fond of the concept because it "highlights small business coffee shops and the unique qualities that each have to offer."

Created by Kangaroo Ridge Farms in Vanceburg, the Trail "connects travelers with independent coffee shops across all nine of the Commonwealth's official tourism regions...from bustling city cafés to small-town roasters tucked between hills and rivers," promotional material said.

"I think that's such a neat concept," Foster said. "This could literally bring people here who have never visited before. Maybe we can introduce more people to Lake Cumberland...and all we have to offer here."

The Kentucky Coffee Trail "was brewed from a simple idea: that a great cup of coffee can bring people together, strengthen communities, and spark pride in the places we call home."

Foster compared the Coffee Trail to the famous Kentucky Bourbon Trail.

"People travel from all over to participate in things like this," she said. "They like to discover new areas...make new friends...and experience unique things. The Kentucky Coffee Trail will present an awesome opportunity for that."

A new app adding an interesting aspect to the coffee trail will soon be launched.

"The app will be

"passports,"" Foster explained. "People grab stamps by scanning a QR Code. The app helps you plan a road trip and map it out for you. Hopefully, it will be launched in about a week."


