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that’s what we’re here for tonight.”

The Jamestown mayor said “a five-member committee...which consisted of three council members, chief of police, and myself...held interviews.”

“Two inside the department that applied for the job,” Mayor Hinton said. “After the interviews and after extensive discussion with the committee on where we felt we should go, I, as mayor of Jamestown, am recommending Nathan Antle to take over the position of chief of police in Jamestown. That’s my recommendation.”

The council accepted Hinton’s recommendation and unanimously voted in the affirmative for Antle as chief.

“First and foremost, I want to thank my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ,” Antle said in accepting the position. “I thank Him for the blessings every day that He’s studied on my life to this point. Without Him, I wouldn’t be

standing here today. I want to thank my friends, my family, my fellow officers, everyone that supported me along my career, my journey. I want to thank you, mayor and council. I really am humbled at your decision. I deeply thank each and every single one of you all. I understand the responsibility that comes along this position, and I don’t take that lightly at all.”

“I look forward to serving with my fellow officers, our community, our city leaders, to continue to move our department forward,” the new police chief pledged. “I think we’ve got a pretty strong department as it is. I think with anything, there’s always room for a little improvement here and there. But I think we’ve got a pretty good department. I thank each and every one of you all and I look forward to it.”

Most recently a member of the Jamestown Police Department (JPD), Antle brings a

wealth of experience by also having served on the Russell Springs Police Department and as a Russell County Deputy Sheriff.

“I think everybody has a lot of confidence,” Mayor Hinton said. “I feel like...the city is going to be in good shape. I know the school is going to be happy to see Jeff come over as school resource officer. So I feel like we’re moving in a good direction.”

Hinton told Antle the “next step” is “to set up the date and do a swearing in to get you sworn into the position, and I guess we’ll go forward from there.”

The city “wanted to push forward as quick as we could because... Jeff has stuff he’s got to do to take over as resource officer,” the Mayor said-noting this week as the start of a new school year.

“We’re looking forward to everything going good in the future and hopefully everything works out well for everybody,” she said.
