ORDINANCE NUMBER 09:2026**

An Ordinance Adopting the City of Morehead, Kentucky Annual Budget For FY 7-1-2025 through 6-30-2026 by Estimating Revenues and Resources and Appropriating Funds for the Operation of City Government, Amendment No. 3 was given first reading on Monday, May 11, 2026 and second reading on Monday, June 8, 2026.

**SUMMARY
GENERAL FUND**

Total Resources Available are increased by \$159,393.29 to a total of \$15,589,471.73. This includes but is not limited to increases to the following: Intergovernmental Revenues are increased for the receipt of National Opioid Settlement funds and TAF Treasury funds. Total Appropriations are increased by \$155,090.17 to a total of \$14,579,552.39. This includes but is not limited to changes to the following: Administration and Finance Expenses are increased by \$117,393.29. Police Expenses are increased by \$1,999.38. No changes to the Fire Expenses. Public Works Expenses are decreased by \$6,302.50. Recreation Expenses are increased by \$42,000.00. No changes to the Capital Outlay Expenses. After the transfer of funds to non-required savings of \$1,000,000.00 and with the afore-mentioned amendments, the Estimated Fund Balance for FY 06-30-2026 is \$9,919.34.

FIRE DEPARTMENT CONSTRUCTION FUND

There were no changes or amendments to the Fire Department Construction Fund. The balance of this fund remains \$6,920,837.00

OTHER FUNDS

There were no changes or amendments to the Municipal Road Aid Funds, CDBG Recovery KY Fund, the Federal Forfeiture Fund-DOJ, the Federal Forfeiture Fund-Treasury or the State Forfeiture Fund.
