RCSHS Vikings fall to the East Carter Raiders, 28-21

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The Rowan County Senior High School Vikings, under first year Head Coach Allen W. Harris, held their 2026 home opener on Friday, Aug. 28, 2026, and lost to the East Carter High School Raiders, 28-21. This loss puts the Vikings at 1-1 after easily defeating Magoffin County, 49-20, on the road, the week before. Vikings QB Matthew Hamilton completed 5 passes from 14 attempts for a total of 84 yards, with 1 interception, while QB Luke Schroeder completed 10 passes from 12 attempts for a total of 161 yards with 2 TD's, and 3 PAT's (points after touchdown). Leading the Vikings in receiving were Cameron Cross with 5 receptions for 112 yards, and 2 TD's; Memphis Hinton with 5 receptions for 82 yards; Jack Richardson with 3 receptions for 39 yards; and Braydon Hall with 2 receptions for 12 yards. Leading the Vikings in rushing were Cameron Cross with 8 carries for 39 yards, which includes 1TD; and Memphis Hinton with 10

carries for 12 yards. Leading the Vikings defense were Brody Barnett with 8 tackles; Hunter Bradshaw with 7 tackles; and Memphis Hinton and Gage Holbrook with 5 tackles each.

The Vikings will play at home again this week when they take on Bath County on Friday, Sept. 4, 2026. Go Vikings!!!

By virtue of a Judgment and Order of Sale entered in the Rowan Circuit Court on August 18, 2026, I will expose for sale to the highest and best bidder, at Rowan County Judicial Center, 700 West Main Street, Morehead, Kentucky, 40351, on Wednesday, September 16, 2026, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., the following described property:

A tract commonly known as 416 Rock Fork Road, Morehead, Kentucky, bearing PVA Map Number 093-00 00 004.03, containing approximately 6 acres, more or less, to include a 2004 Champion mobile home which has been converted to real estate, and being the same land conveyed to George C. Tackett, et ux, by deed dated January 28, 2013, and recorded in Deed Book 246, Page 743, of the Rowan County Records.
