TO ALL INTERESTED AGENCIES, GROUPS, AND PERSONS:

#### Request for Release of Funds

On or about March 16, 2026, the City of Columbus will submit a request to the Department for Local Government for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) to undertake the following project:

The City of Columbus in Hickman County KY, is moving forward with the Columbus Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation is renovating, upgrading, and improving their Water Treatment Plant to directly benefit the water quality for current water utility customers. The focus of this project encompasses comprehensive repairs to the existing treatment plant in addition to replacing aging water meters in the system to improve the existing service provided by the City's infrastructure

HUD Funding: \$900,000  
Total Project Cost: \$1,800,000

#### Finding of No Significant Impact

The City of Columbus has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) (PL-91-190) is not required. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) respecting the within project has been made by the City of Columbus which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the Purchase Area Development District, 1002 Medical Drive, Mayfield, KY 42066, and is available for public examination and copying, upon request, at the City of Columbus, 14503 State Route 123 W Columbus, KY 42032 between the hours of 9 A.M. and 4 P.M. No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted.

#### Public Comments

All interested agencies, groups, and persons disagreeing with the ERR decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the City of Columbus to Mayor Kay Ferguson. Such written comments should be received at the mayor's office on or before March 13, 2026. All such comments so received will be considered prior to authorizing submission of a request for a release of funds or taking any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified on the proceeding sentence. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

#### Environmental Certification

The City of Columbus will undertake the project described above with Block Grant funds from the Department for Local Government under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The City of Columbus is certifying to the state that the City of Columbus and Kay Ferguson, in her official capacity as Mayor, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The legal effect of the certification is that upon its approval the City of Columbus may use the Block Grant funds, and the state and HUD will have satisfied their responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and related laws and authorities.

#### Objection to Release of Funds

The state will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Columbus certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission dates March 16, 2026, or its actual receipt for the request (whichever is the later) only if they are on one of the following bases:

- (a) The certification was not in fact executed by the City of Columbus Certifying Officer.
- (b) The City of Columbus has failed to make one of the two findings pursuant to S58.41 or to make the written determination decision required by S578.57, 58.53 or 58.64 for the project, as applicable.
- (c) The City of Columbus has omitted one or more of the steps set forth at Subparts F and G for the preparation and completion of an EA.
- (d) No opportunity was given to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation or its Executive Director to review the effect of the project on a property listed on the National Register of Historic Places or found to be eligible for such listing by the Secretary of the Interior, in accordance with 36 CFR Part 800.
- (e) The recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR part 58 before approval of the release of funds and approval of the Environmental Certification by HUD or the State.
- (f) Another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality.

Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Department for Local Government, Office of Federal Grants, 100 Airport Road 3rd Floor, Kentucky 40601.

Objections to the release of funds on bases other than those stated above will not be considered by the state. No objection received after March 31, 2026, will be considered by the state. Potential objectors should contact the Department for Local Government to verify the actual last day of the state Comment period.
